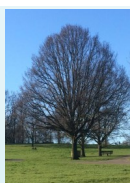

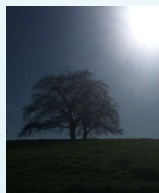
Bronze and Gold Duke of Edinburgh
