Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope that this letter finds you and your family well. Please rest assured that despite the ongoing situation with Covid19 we are very much looking forward to welcoming your child into Sixth Form.

Results day will take place on **Thursday 20th August**. On this day students will be asked to sign up to reserve their place in Sixth Form, and will be given the Sixth Form handbook along with an enrolment form. If you are not able to pick up results in person, please reserve your place by emailing j.west@stgeorgesrc.org

Enrolment into Year 12 will take place on **Friday 4th September**. Students need to come into school in person on this day in order to choose three subjects.

Over the course of the past academic year, our Sixth Form community has enjoyed a number of successes and we aim to develop those further over the coming year. We are delighted that a high percentage of our students have offers this year from the Russell Group of universities.

The main aim of our Sixth Form is to ensure that our young people are fully equipped for university, further education or employment. As you would expect from the standards that you have experienced so far at this school, our expectations of our senior students will be equally high.

Excellent attendance and punctuality are expected, as is a well-motivated approach to the hard work that is ahead. Appearance is also expected to be of the highest calibre, with the appropriate uniform to be worn daily (further information overleaf); Hairstyles should be modest and sensible, not coloured, lined or exaggerated. Shoes should be traditional in style. No visible/piercings/tattoos are permitted. Mobile phones are permitted but are not allowed in lessons or around the school. Compliance with this code of behaviour and attitude is expected from all students with the support of their parents/carers. Failure to adhere to these will result in sanctions, which, may, in extreme instances, lead to dismissal.

I make no apology for the above regulations and firmly believe that any distractions to learning, which, given the limited time that the students have remaining, should not be encouraged.

Please be aware that we plan on running a full curriculum with Year 12 lessons as normal from September. We will undertake a full risk assessment before pupils return to school and students will be taught separately from other year groups. The guidance is constantly being updated given the changing situation with Covid19. Please keep checking the school website for further details as more guidance is released.

Uniform:

BOYS: Plain (not patterned, striped or checked) charcoal grey business suit (matching trousers and jacket), white shirt, red or grey v neck sweater (optional), red tie (clip on – to be purchased from www.uniform4kids.com) and conventional black shoes. A single stud earring may be worn and a modest amount of jewellery (a single necklace/ single bracelet/a single ring on each hand etc).

GIRLS: Plain (not patterned, striped or checked) charcoal grey business suit with matching traditional jacket, trousers, skirt or dress, black/neutral tights (not patterned), white reverse neck blouse, red or grey v neck sweater (optional), conventional black shoes. A modest amount of jewellery (a single necklace/ single bracelet/ a single pair of gold or silver stud earrings/a single ring on each hand etc) and makeup (no false nails/eyelashes etc) is permitted. Neutral nail polish may be worn.

Registration Fee

In order to confirm your son/daughter's place in Year 12, a **non-refundable £50 registration fee** is required to be paid before their induction day on Friday 4th September 2020. Payment should be made via ParentPay, of which details will be given to them on results day. If this payment is not made, it may result in your son/daughter's place being withdrawn.
